## **Primary Purpose of the Role**

Through the delivery of settlement, English language, vocational training and employment services AMES assists newly arrived migrants and refugees to build their new life in Australia. A Mentor supports the assigned mentee in his/her pursuit of employment and a career in Australia. Mentees are currently or have been enrolled in the Skilled Professional Migrant Program.

### Relevant information

- The role voluntary and unpaid
- A commitment of approximately one hour per week is required.
- Engagement is subject to the needs of the program and satisfactory interview, police check, induction process and satisfactory performance and conduct.

## Role requirements

- To support and empower the Mentee towards gaining employment, pursuing their career.
- To develop an increased understanding of Australian workplace culture and the Australian employment system.
- To maintain regular contact with the Mentor Coordinator to report on activities and outcomes.

- Current knowledge and experience of the Australian workplace.
- Good interpersonal and communication skills.
- An understanding of and empathy with people from diverse and cultural backgrounds.
- A non-judgemental attitude.
- Ability to work independently.

## Qualifications

- Significant Australian Workplace experience in your profession.
- Mentor to be currently employed or recently retired.

Initial induction and ongoing support will be provided by the Mentor Program Coordinator.
